County of Hampshire now conversant in  
Salem in our said County of Essex mariner

by the consideration of our Justices of our Court of Common Pleas, holden at Ipswich  
for and within our County of Essex aforesaid, on the last Monday of March 1807  
recovered judgment against

Jonathan Pele, Joseph Winn, Willard  
Pele, Pickering Dodge, and John Winn and  
Nathaniel Appleton all of said Salem Merchants

\$282.90 for the sum of Two hundred eighty Two dollars ninety  
83.80 cents damages & Eighty three dollars eighty cents  
366.70

366.95 costs of suit, as to us appears of record, whereof execution remains to be done :

We command you, therefore, that of the goods, chattels or lands of the said  
Jonathan, Joseph, Willard, Pickering, John, & Nathaniel  
within your precinct, you cause to be paid and satisfied unto the said Hartwell

at the value thereof in money, the aforesaid sums, being \$366.70  
in the whole, with Twenty five cents more for this  
writ, and thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees. And for want of goods, chattels  
or lands of the said

Jonathan Joseph Willard, Pickering, John & Nathaniel  
to be by them shewn unto you, or found  
within your precinct, to the acceptance of the said Hartwell

we command you to take the body of the said Jonathan Joseph Willard  
Pickering, John and Nathaniel to satisfy the sums aforesaid ;

\_\_\_\_\_ and them commit unto our gaol in  
Salem, Ipswich or Newburyport, in our County of  
Essex aforesaid, and detain in your custody  
within our said gaol, until they pay the full sums above mentioned, with your fees, or that  
they be discharged by the said Hartwell

the creditor, or otherwise by order of law. Hereof fail not ; and make  
return of this writ, with your doings therein, into our said Court of Common Pleas, to be  
holden at Salem within our County of Essex aforesaid, upon the last  
Monday of June next.
